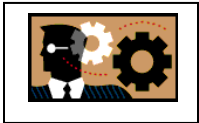

you, **Roger**.*

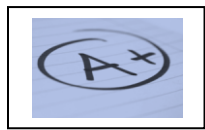


*The Rummage Sale was

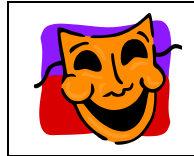
