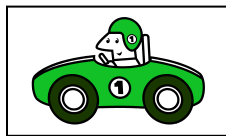

*Please observe the Park speed limit of 15 mph. Many of our residents have a hard time getting out of the way.*

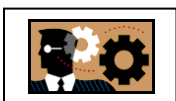
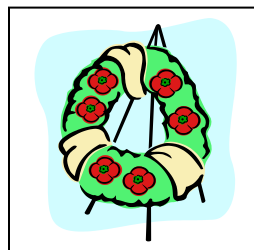

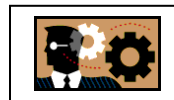

From now on drawings conducted by MMSC will be a 50-25-25 format.

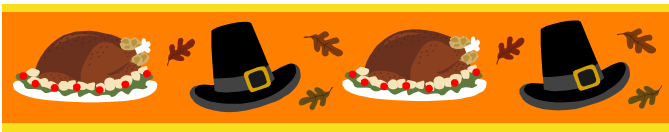

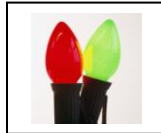
