*Coffee & Donuts will be offered on Oct. 6th, 13th, 20th, & 27th, hosted by **Bonnie G. and Judy G.***

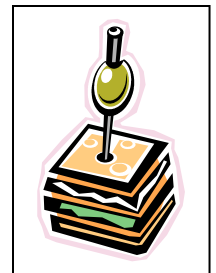
