of the eight positions are contested. Bob Gilliland and Glenn McGill are running for President while John Horan, Rodney Waryasz, and Sondra Hale are running for two of the Director's positions. Falk Ware, Vice President; Pauline Lacourse, Secretary; and Kathy Holder, Treasurer are unopposed. Charlene Womack has one year remaining on her first term as a Director at Large and Pauline Lacourse's current position will be vacant until the new Board fills it. Current Board members, Butch Sims, Karla Gentry, Maureen Huff, and Tim Burchfield are not running for re-election.

Haven't voted? There's still time. You can seek out one of the two Election Commissioners, Vito DeFrancesco at 112 Torch Lane or Kathleen Ballantine Watson at 361 Lantern Lane. You can meet them at the Community Center at one of three appointed times: Saturday January 27th from 8 am to 9 am, Tuesday January 30th from 1130 am to 1230 pm, or Thursday February 1st from 130 pm to 230 pm.

You can still mail it to the P.O. Box address on the return envelop included with your ballot. Be careful. No ballots will be accepted after 230 pm on February 1st. As stated in last month's Mobile Manor Monthly, any other attempt to have your ballot count will be futile.

If you want to vote but are not up-todate with your 2017 fees, it is too late!! The By Laws state "To be a member "In Good Standing" for the Annual Meeting in February, all fees for the preceding twelve (12) months must be paid by December 31st......" This was also stated in Mobile Manor Monthly as recently as December, 2017.
