Community Meeting - Jan. 4<sup>th</sup> at 230 pm at the CC. Board Meeting - Jan. 23<sup>rd</sup> at 2 pm at the office.

The maintenance fee for 2018 is \$28.00 per month or \$336 annually.





Mobile Manor will hold their first Community meeting of 2018 on Jan. 4<sup>th</sup> at 230 pm at the Community Center.

At that meeting, the three member nominating committee (Chairperson Ron Kirk, Kathleen Ballantine Watson, and Tim Burchfield) will present the list of candidates that they have found who will run for positions on Mobile Manor's Board Directors. their of After presentation, the voting members of the community present at the meeting will be asked if there are any other nominations. If there are, those names will be added to the list. That list will be used to prepare the ballot for the election which will conclude at the February Community Meeting on February 1<sup>st</sup>. This ballot will only deal with races which are contested. For example, if only one person is running for Secretary, that won't appear on the ballot. Sometime later in January (at least 20 days prior to the February Community Meeting) voting members of Mobile Manor will receive the prepared ballot. There are only two ways to vote: 1.) mail the completed ballot to a designated P.O. Box, or 2.) hand the completed ballot to one of the two Election Commissioners (Vito DeFrancesco or Mic Gray). Any other attempt to have your ballot count will be futile, so do not take it to the office, mail it to the office, put it through the slot at the office, give it to a Board member, or send it by carrier pigeon. There will be opportunities to vote at the Community Center, but that will involve handing your ballot to one of the Election Commissioners.

Everyone who is eligible to vote will also receive a second document which looks like a ballot, but it is actually a proxy. This item can only be used if you are not able to attend the Annual Meeting on February 1, 2018. If you choose to use it, it allows the Board Secretary, Maureen Huff, to express your wishes regarding the changes to the Mobile Manor, Inc. By Laws. Because of the current By Laws, this is the only legal way for people who can't attend to have their say. The proxies may be mailed to a designated P.O. Box or left at Secretary Huff's residence.

Directions, dates and times to vote in the clubhouse, and the addresses of the Election Commissioners, Secretary Huff, and the P.O. Box, will be in the election packet voters receive.
